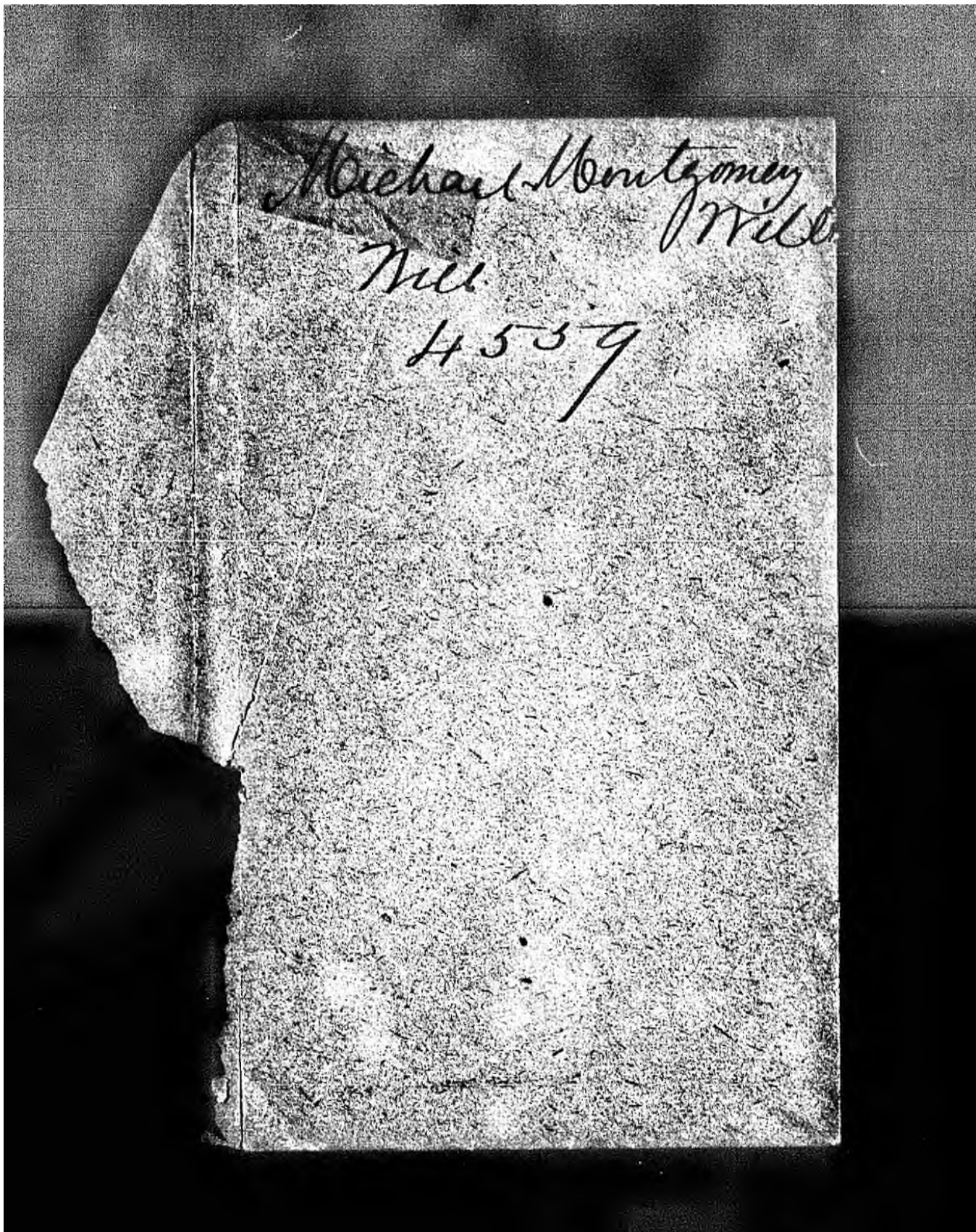

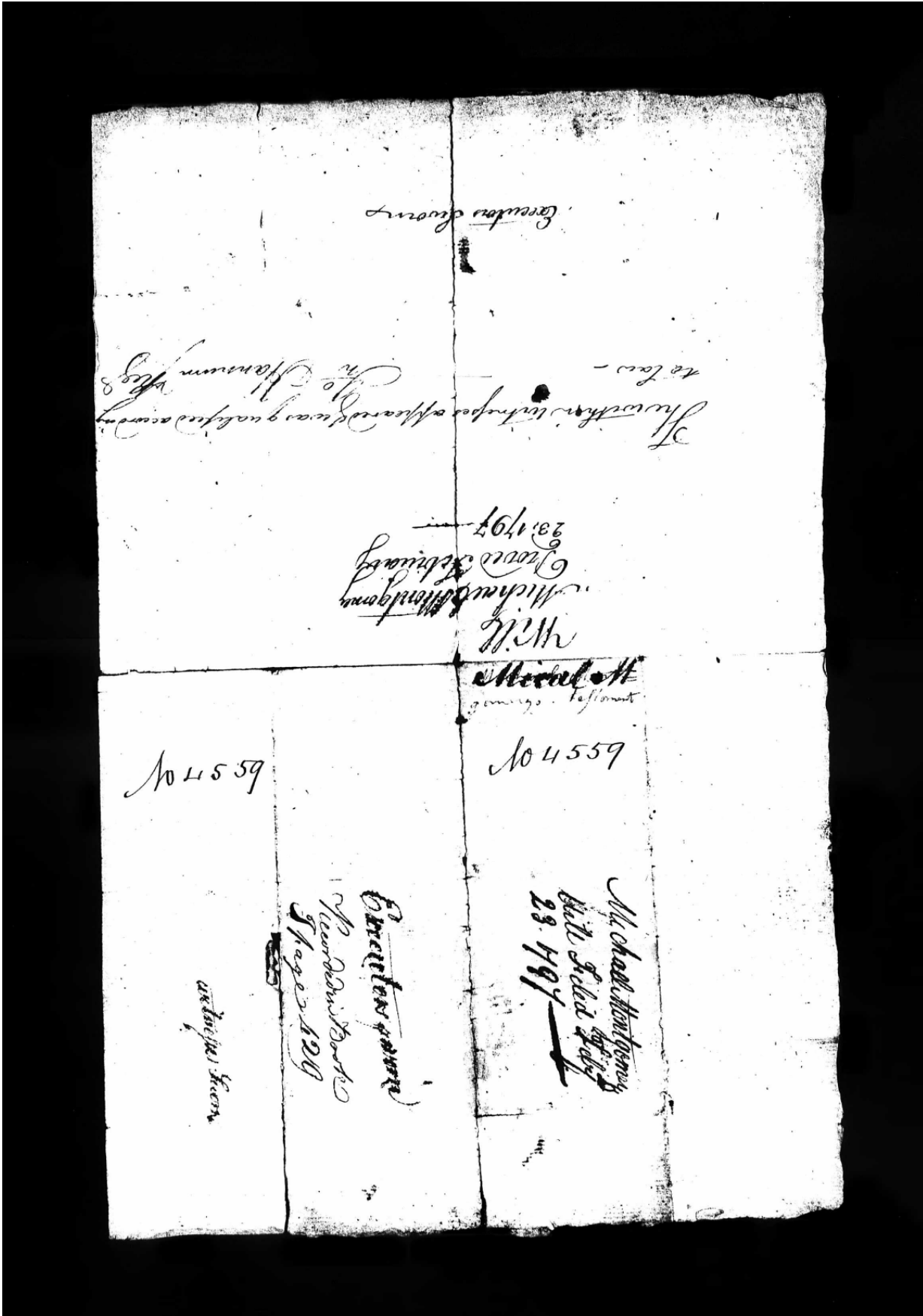

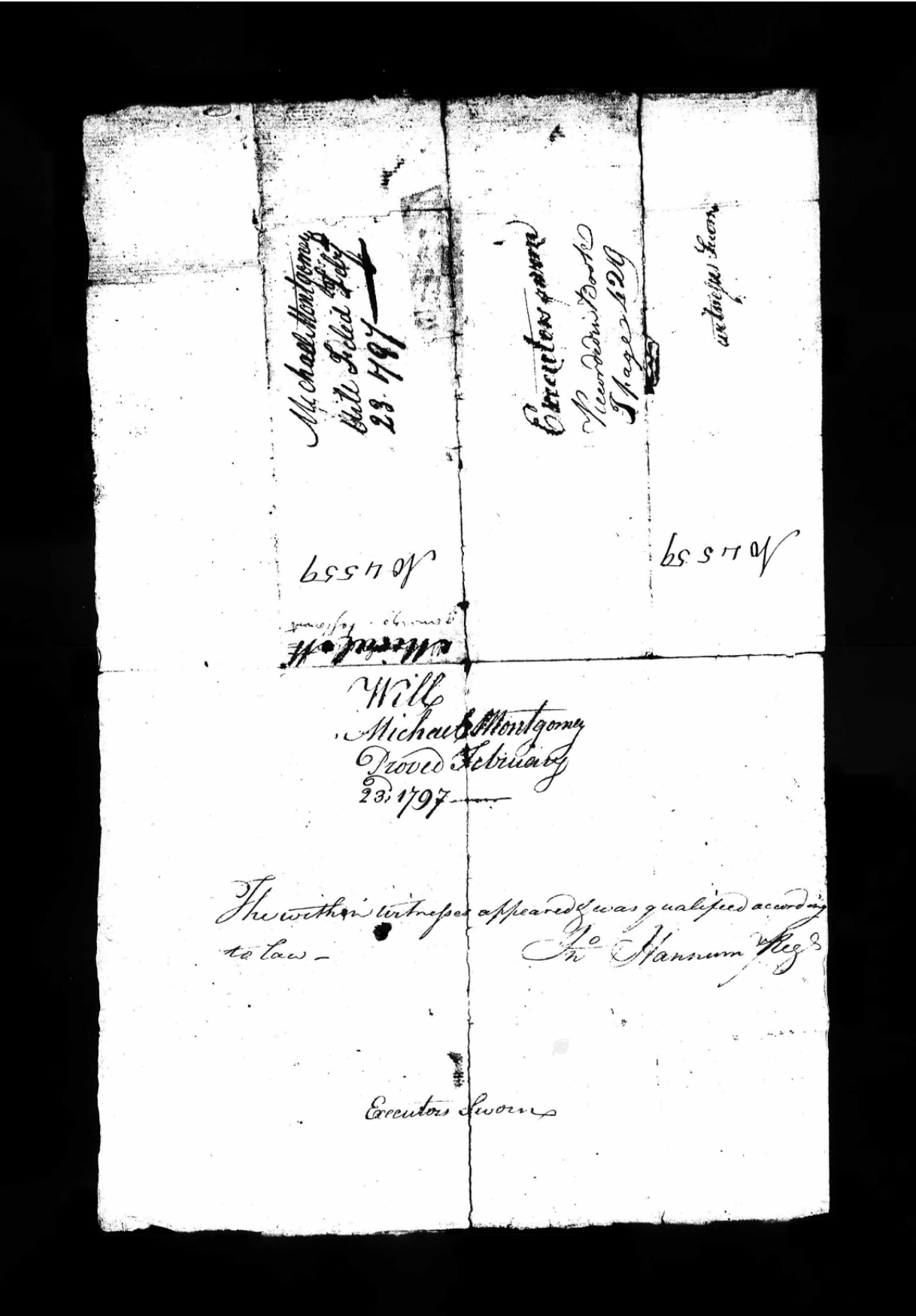

In the Name of God Amen, I Michael Montgome-
 ry of Chester County & State of Pennsylvania being
 weak in body, but of sound Mind and Memory, consider-
 ing the certainty of Death, & the uncertainty of the Time
 thereof, & being desirous to settle my worldly affairs, &
 thereby be the better prepared to leave this world when
 it shall please God to call me hence, do therefore
 make & publish this my last will & testament, in man-
 ner & form following, that is to say.

I first & principally I commit my soul into the hands of
 Almighty God, and my body to the earth, to be decently buried
 at the discretion of my Executors herein after named, and,
 after my debts & funeral charges are paid, I devise & bequeath
 as follows.

I give & bequeath unto my Dear Wife Nancey Montgomery
 one third part of my Estate both real & personal during her
 natural life.

Item. I give unto my Eldest Son John my House & Cocks
 ten shillings.

Item. I give unto my Son William ten shillings.

Item. I give unto my Daughter Hannah ten shillings.

Item. I give unto my Daughter Ann ten shillings.

Item. I give and devise unto my two Sons Robert
 and Samuel all the real & personal of my Estate both
 real & personal to be equally divided between them, share
 & share alike, to them, their heirs, & assigns.

And lastly. I do hereby constitute & appoint my two Sons
 Robert and Samuel, to be Executors of this my last will
 and testament; revoking & annulling all former wills by
 me heretofore made; ratifying & confirming this and none other to
 be my last will & testament.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my
 Seal, this twenty third Day of February anno dominici one
 thousand seven hundred & ninety two.

Signed, sealed, published, and declared by
 Michael Montgomery, the above named testa-
 tor, as and for his last will & testament, in the
 presence of us, who at his request, and in his pres-
 ence have subscribed our names as witnesses thereto.
